## Community Cohesion Update November 2024

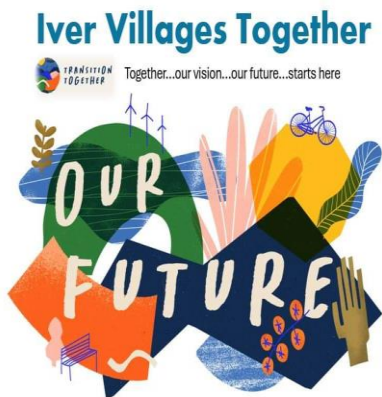
Welcome to our Community Cohesion update #5
