We hope you all had a wonderful Easter break.

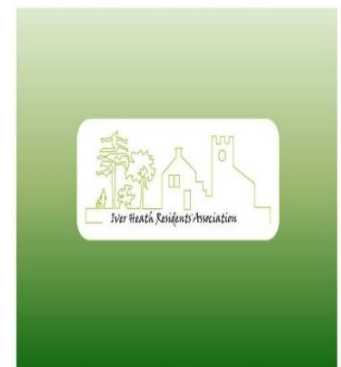
