## Enhancement opportunities



To enhance our broad and balanced curriculum, every child will have a wide range of enrichment activities to enjoy and give context to their learning. These will include a range of visits and visitors to the school for example: a trip to Windsor Castle and a visit from the Space Dome as well as the opportunity for a residential stay away.\* We offer a wide range of enriching activities outside of the normal school day through our extensive selections of clubs. So whether you want to socialise at breakfast club; be musical in choir; be creative in our Lego club or show your sporting prowess in netball and multi-sports, or we can offer it.

## Wrap Around Care

Here at IHJS, we run an in-house Breakfast Club from 7.45am. Children can come in, eat a healthy breakfast, share some time with their friends and then prepare themselves for the day ahead.

Our after-school club is run by JAG, who provide a fun and stimulating range of activities until any time up until 6pm daily. Their friendly and highly-trained staff ensure that the children in their care are happy and healthy and want to come to their club.



# Learning Environment

Our school is set in spacious grounds which allows us to offer excellent learning opportunities both in and out of the classroom. Through the staff and children's dedicated efforts we have utilised both the classrooms and our shared areas in the school and created a stimulating learning environment where children's learning and achievements are celebrated.

# Pastoral Care

Feeling safe and happy at school ensures your child will be ready to learn and reach their potential. We aim to develop their resilience, confidence and self-esteem. Where children need a little boost in these areas, we provide a range of interventions and support to help them develop. We were the first primary school in Buckinghamshire to work with Bucks Mind to implement the role of Peer Mentors during our playtimes.

We have high expectations of behaviour and conduct in our children. As such we promote positive and mutually respectful relationships between children, staff and parents.

The safeguarding and welfare of the children in our school is paramount and as such we follow Buckinghamshire's Child Protection procedures. We have a Child Protection Policy, which reflects both our statutory duty and pastoral responsibilities. We have three Designated Safeguarding Leads, who deal with any safeguarding concerns.



## School meals and Snacks

Firstly, we encourage every child to have a water bottle in school and to drink throughout the day to stay hydrated, which will help them to focus.

We also encourage children to bring a healthy snack of fruit, vegetables or a cereal bar to eat during break time, to keep them going until lunchtime. Please avoid sugary sweets and chocolate and crisps.

*As we are a nut-free school, no nuts or produce containing nuts please.*

Children may bring a packed-lunch or purchase a hot meal from The Pantry. They are a local company who provide a good range of healthy and tasty meals.



## Uniform
