### New members of the school community in class 3I

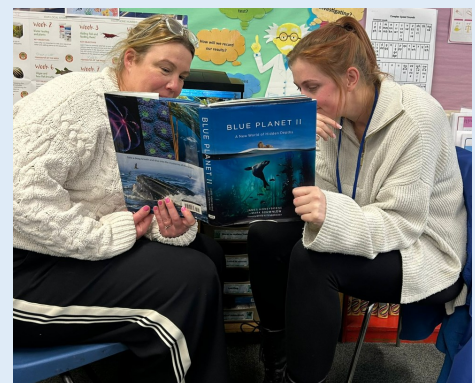
We have signed up to a 9-week programme called *Fishkeeper Fry*. Fry are baby fish, by the way it's got nothing to do with fish and chips!

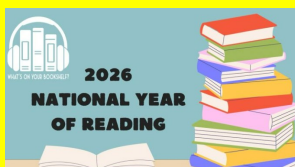
Poppy's Place
