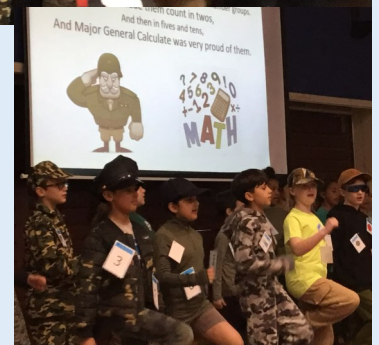
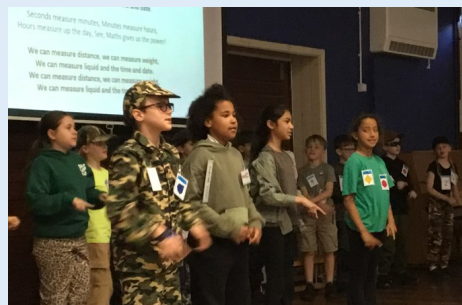
Classes have been over to the Iver Heath Library to complete some activities kindly organised by the team over there. Here are some pics of children sharing their thoughts on books.

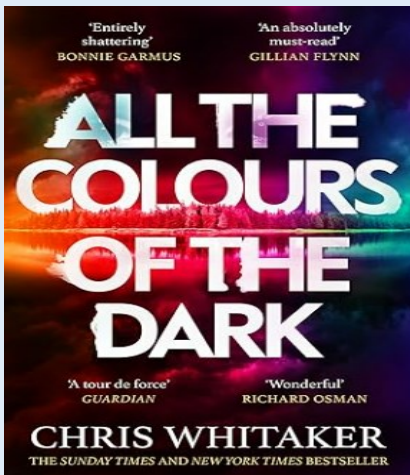


The **gardening/eco club** have been bust **planting their lettuces, tomatoes and now strawberries** into the poly-

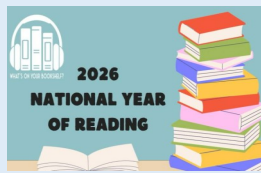
