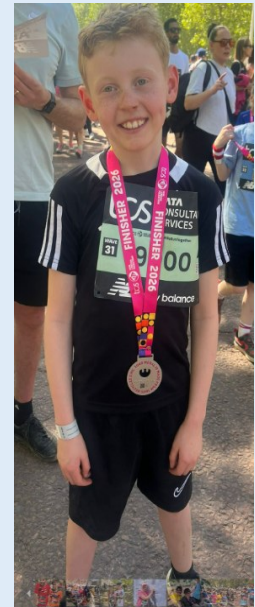
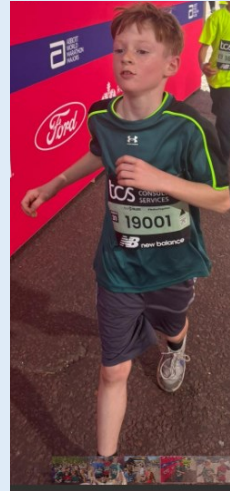


Well-Done to all of our Iver Heath marathon superstars who took part in the mini marathon last Saturday. What a great job you all did; we are very proud of you.

Over the next couple of weeks, our focus is going to be on litter



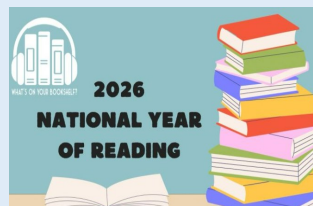
