To take advantage of this offer, tickets must be purchased by **Wednesday 8th October** via School Money. Please note that the deadline is absolute as we need to confirm numbers with Legoland and pay them in advance.

The discounted price is only available if at least 50 tickets are purchased. If we do not meet this minimum, the event will not go ahead and you will receive a full refund. You will be informed no later than 10 days before the event if it is cancelled. If the event proceeds, tickets will be shared with you.

If possible, consider car sharing as parking is not included and is £2 cheaper if you prepay ahead.

Please note this is not a school trip and all children must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
