I have been made aware of an APP called Coverstar that is potentially dangerous for children. The APP allows users to create, play and connect in a positive community. It's sold as the safest alternative to Tik-Tok for young people. Please note, this is not true. I have been informed that a primary age child was sent nude images of a male adult through this APP. This has obviously been traumatising for the child concerned. If your child is using Coverstar, I would strongly suggest you delete the APP.

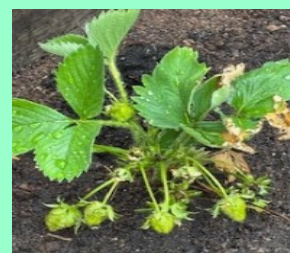
Gardening club have started their **Plant Books** to help them keep a record of the species we have on
