

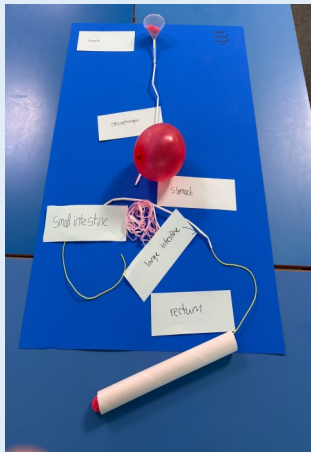

### Super Science

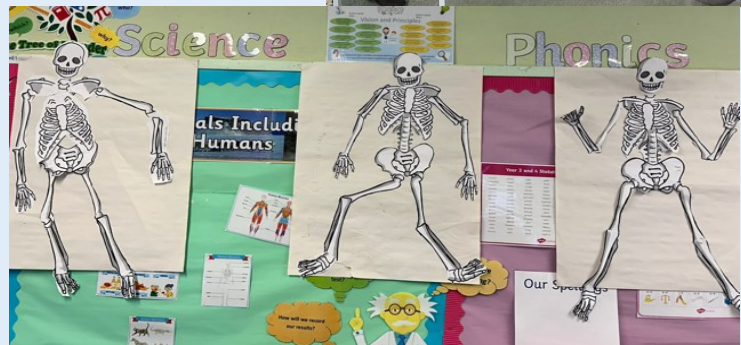

## Special price offer

The PTA have managed to secure discounted tickets to Legoland Windsor Resort theme park on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> October (school inset day).

Tickets are **£25 each**—adult and child tickets are priced the same. (Current online price is £39pp). To take advantage of this offer, tickets must be purchased by **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> October** via School Money. Please note that the deadline is absolute as we need to confirm numbers with Legoland and pay them in advance.

The discounted price is only available if at least 50 tickets are purchased. If we do not meet this minimum, the event will not go ahead and you will receive a full refund. You will be informed no later than 10 days before the event if it is cancelled. If the event proceeds, tickets will be shared with you.

If possible, consider car sharing as parking is not included and is £2 cheaper if you prepay ahead.
